of a significant building outside the Historic District under the Westport Demolition Bylaw (as amended on 5.2.07)

A significant building is any building included on the Westport Historical Inventory compiled by the Westport Historical Commission. It includes "any building that is a shelter for a person, animal or property. Demolition means the pulling down, destroying, removing or razing of any building or a substantial portion thereof."

The purpose of this application is to allow the Westport Historical Commission to determine if the significant building in question is "a preferably-preserved significant building" which may be subject to delay in its demolition up to 365-days.

The applicant must be the current owner(s) or trustee of the property.
