	<i>MATERIAL</i>	<i>PREPARATION</i>	
Paper	Newspaper with inserts.	Bundle in paper bags or tie securely.	No books or magazines. No plastic strings or plastic bags.
Junk Mail	Any junk mail, magazines, white & color paper		No paper bags, plastic bags, cardboard, or string of any type.
Glass	Empty, unbroken bottles & jars. Clear & colored glass.	Rinse. Remove all metal & plastic caps, lids, rings, & foils.	No plates, windows, or auto glass. No ceramics, dinnerware, Pyrex, mirrors, or light bulbs.
Plastic	Empty milk & detergent jugs. Any container with ① & ② symbol on the bottom.	Rinse & remove all caps. Flatten items, if possible. Labels can be left on. Separate ② milk jugs; all others; ① clear	Any container that doesn't have the ① or ② symbol on the bottom.
Cans	Empty aluminum & tin food or beverage cans. Pie plates & aluminum foil.	Rinse. Flatten tin cans, if possible. Labels can be left on.	No aerosol cans.
Clothes	Clean, usable clothing. Any type accepted	Bring clothing in a bag. Place in the designated containers.	
Scrap Metal	Cast iron sinks, stoves, lawn mowers, metal bedsprings, washers, dryers, & any kind of metal. Must be 100% metal.	Remove doors. No FREON items: refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, or utilities with coolant. Suggest going to <i>Excel Recycling or Mid-City Scrap.</i>	No capacitors in the white goods. If part of the original equipment, they must be brought intact and removed in presence of attendant. No automobile bodies. No metal parts tainted with oil or grease.
Batteries	All batteries incl. cell phones		No leaks. Cannot be broken or cracked.
Card-board	Corrugated, including paperboard (cereal boxes etc.)	Flatten boxes.	No waxed cardboard.
Waste-Motor Oil	Up to 2 Gallons/Household/Day	Name & address required. Must not be contaminated with any other compounds including water.	Antifreeze, contaminated oil, solvents.
Paint – 10 & 5 Gal. limit	Latex, Water, Oil, Stains, Varnishes. April thru October ONLY	Keep in original container, tightly sealed & pack in carton or box. Place label on can if original not legible.	No mixing paint. No packing in bags. No unmarked or illegible containers. No creosote. 10 & 15 gal. Limit/person
Mercury	Fluorescent bulbs & thermometers		Not Broken
Ink Cart. Cell Phone	Any ink cartridges & any cell phone. Container at shed		No cell phone batteries or cell phone accessories.

Yard Waste	Leaves, pine needles, weeds & grass clippings, shrubs.	May be left in biodegradable paper bags. No plastic bags. NO STUMPS.	No food waste. No commercial yard waste.
Chip Wood	Prunings, brush, & logs. <i>(Call office first-Check to see if we are currently taking it.)</i>	Tie with non-wire or non-plastic string or twine with butts facing same directions-- 4 FT. Lengths.	No bundles above 60 pounds. Wooden Gutters/Shingles are not recyclable. No commercial chip wood

NOTE: Please separate any unflattened deposit bottles/cans for designated areas. Proceeds for Westport Music Boosters.

ALL OTHER HAZARDOUS WASTE: Will have to wait until Household Hazardous Waste Day, which is once every other year. Please inquire at the Selectman's Office 636-1003

STICKERS: \$10.00 - Each Vehicle
Stickers are indefinite or until the BOH issues new stickers. If replacing vehicle or a broken window, must peel off old sticker and bring to office to receive a replacement at no charge.

PUNCH CARDS: \$15.00 (card has 5 punches each worth \$3)
\$30.00 (card has 10 punches each worth \$3)
Punch cards to be used ONLY for bags of trash or a barrel up to 33 gallons

TRASH: \$3.00 Each Bag up to 33-Gallon Size

BULKY ITEMS: Up to \$30 Ea. Item, which depends on the size/type of item (ex: mattress, box spring, chair, sofa w/bed, sectionals, rug, table, bureau, etc.) Attendant will assess the correct fee.

METAL

BULKY ITEMS: No Charge (example washer, dryer, lawnmower, stove, etc.) **NO** items with **FREON** (example: refrigerator, air conditioner, dehumidifiers, etc.)
