What is an Inactive Voter?

- If you don't respond to the Annual Street List, you'll be put on the inactive voter list.
- If you are on the inactive voter list, you can still vote. Bring identification to your polling place. You must fill out an Affirmation of Current and Continuous Residence. This allows you to cast your ballot. You'll be added to the active voter list.
- If you do not vote in two consecutive federal elections while you're inactive, you will no longer be registered to vote. You should register to vote again.
- Inactive voters remain registered to vote until they fail to vote in two consecutive biennial state elections. Inactive voters are restored to the active voters list any time they complete an Affirmation of Current and Continuous Residence, fill out a new voter registration form, or submit anything to their local election official which is signed under penalty of perjury and confirms the voter's address.

Non-Voters are Residents that have not registered to vote and/or are underage.
